



Congratulations on purchasing the BOSS Spray Pack. This unit is unique in its design.

Important user information

Do not operate the BOSS Spray Pack slung from only one shoulder. Always use both of the shoulder straps and the chest strap when in operation. Your back will thank you if you use the BOSS properly.

The BOSS Spray Pack has been ergonomically designed and manufactured to be more comfortable and easier to use than those previously seen on the Australian market.

Like all spray packs of this size, it has been designed predominantly for use in blacking out operations, suppressing very small low intensity fires and patrolling a fire edge. No spray pack will provide burn over protection in a high intensity fire.

The BOSS Spray Pack is a collapsible unit designed to be stored empty and filled only when required. After use, the spray pack should be emptied and the hose and hand pump disconnected and also emptied. For ease of storage, place the dry pack and the dry pump into its storage bag.

The Spray Pack holds a maximum of 20 litres of water filled via the filler cap located on top of the pack. It is only necessary to fill the unit to a weight that is comfortable for the operator to carry.

The solid brass hand pump has a spray deflector plate located at the nozzle that is designed to interrupt the jet flow (when required) and create a spray pattern. The pump is also fitted with a shut off valve to prevent back flow through the pump.

The BOSS spray pack is provided with a 5-year warranty.

Only use water in the spray pack bladder and hand pump. Do not store wet or with sharp objects or chemicals. Empty and dry the spray back completely before long-term storage. Physical wear and tear is not covered under the warranty.
